STIRLING artist and arts promoter Amy Sierp-Worth is launching her on-line gallery tomorrow (September 1) with an exhibition *Sublimation* at Fisher Jeffries, Gouger Street, Adelaide.

It will be launched by Amy along with Nicholas Linke of Fisher Jeffries, with guest speaker Giles Bettison, internationally acclaimed glass artist.

Amy enjoys both sides of art – the practice and promotion.

Over the past 15 years she has been working in glass, in Adelaide and in Bali, as well as curating exhibitions and organising arts events.

“I’m very passionate about art,” she says. “And I’m very much a doer – I like to get things done.

“Many artists are too busy to spend time on promotion and the business side, so this is where I can help.”

Now a mother of two, she works from home and has set up the on-line Worth Gallery, to promote the work of Hills, SA and interstate artists.

She also assists artists by finding venues to display their work, such as the Coventry Library, Stirling.

Her site covers opportunities for sales, commissions, investment, and leasing works for commercial premises.

It also enables art-lovers to view new works without leaving home.
