

# Glass and water



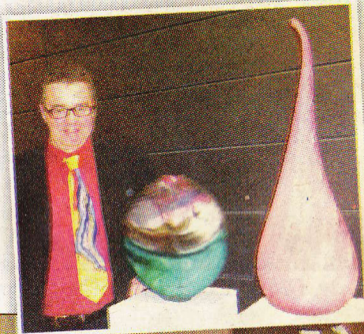
